



## Gas Safety - what you need to know



Cookers and boilers sometimes use gas. These need checking every year to make sure they are safe.



#### Danger

If gas equipment is not checked it can get dangerous. It lets off a gas you cannot see or smell, called Carbon Monoxide.



People die from Carbon Monoxide poisoning every year.

# How do I know if I'm being poisoned by carbon monoxide?



You might have carbon monoxide poisoning if:

you get very tired or sleepy quickly



you get a headache for no reason



you begin to feel sick in your stomach

you get sudden stomach pains

you get sudden chest pains.

If you think that you have carbon monoxide poisoning, see a doctor as fast as you can!

## **Safety Checks**



Every year we have to check all the gas equipment you have to make sure it is safe. We have to do this by law.



We will mend our equipment and tell you about any problems any of your things have, like your own cooker.



The checks are free and the law says we have to do them.



If you do not let us in to do them you can get into trouble and will have to pay our costs. These could be up to £200.

## When we visit



#### We will:

 send you a letter saying when we want to do the checks, please tell us if you will not be in




show you our Gas Safe identity card




be polite and helpful



not make any mess



test your alarms



 tell you what we have done and anything else that needs doing



 give you a certificate to say we have done the checks



answer any questions you have.



Every now and again we check up on our work to make sure it is done well. Sometimes, we might get in touch with you to ask if we can do this.

## What to do if you smell gas




If you think you smell gas:


 Put out any flames you have like candles.



2. Open all your windows and doors.



3. Do not switch anything on or use any switches.



4. Turn off the gas at the meter.



5. Ring the gas emergency number:

0800 111 999

# Things you must not do



If you use gas there are some things you must never do.

You must not:





Flames should be blue, look out for yellow or orange flames or any soot



cover any gas equipment



cover or block any air vents



 do any work on gas equipment yourself. This is against the law.
